

LSIA: Football Championship Series Experience



2015 marked the first partnership between the Sport Management Program at Texas A&M University and the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision. The successful partnership will continue for 2017 allowing for 10 students to work on location at the NCAA Division I Football Championship game. The event is held at Toyota Stadium in Frisco, Texas. The students will assist the FCS staff with the execution of the event through game day on January 7th. The FCS experience is an opportunity presented to both undergraduate and graduate current HLKN students. An application and interview process is conducted by Dr. Hudson.

An event this large has various components including event management, marketing, and game presentation. This year students will work on either an in-venue or social team. The in-venue group will assist in several pre-game events as well as activities that take place during the game on Saturday, January 7th. The social team will assist with the social needs of the pre-game events and press conferences as well as the social activities during the championship game. Our agreement with the Football Championship Subdivision is that our students will be supervised by Dr. Shane Hudson and assist the FCS staff as needed.

Students will be in Frisco, Texas from **January 5th – 7th** for the FCS Championship game.

To Apply:

- **500 word essay**- describing your skills and qualifications
- **500 word essay**- research on the Football Championship Subdivision
- **Resume** that includes 3 references and their contact information
- Please attach a cover page to the application packet
- Undergraduate students must create a Top Gun account (<http://topgun.tamu.edu/>)
 - Print your bio page from this account to include in the application documents
- Applications are due in Dr. Hudson's office by **Friday, 5:00 PM, September 30th**
- Students will be notified by **October 21st** of acceptance or denial
